Purposes and legal basis of data processing

We process your personal data to the extent necessary to perform a contract and for customer service (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR), to process contact enquiries (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR) and for any advertising purposes for our own services (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR). It is our legitimate interest to process your contact enquiries and to conduct direct marketing.

Recipients and storage period

Depending on the type of contact made, we may pass on your personal data to external service providers whom we have retained for processing. After processing your enquiry, your personal data will be stored in accordance with the relevant storage obligations under tax and commercial law and then erased. Accounting documents are stored for a full 10 years in accordance with Sec. 147 of the German Fiscal Code (AO), business documents are stored for a full 6 years in accordance with Sec. 257 of the German Commercial Code (HGB).
